- Research-based education from North Carolina State University and North Carolina A&T State University

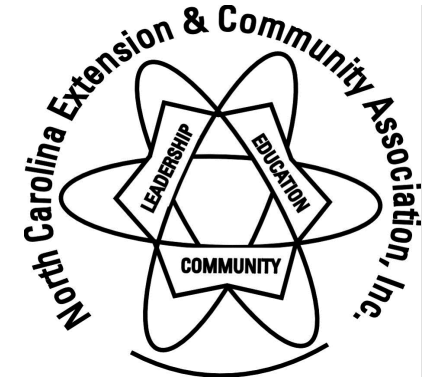
